

DIFFUSE ALOPECIA

DIFFUSE, is a type of hair loss which is difficult to detect in a short space of time, we could say that the quantity of hair which is lost is greater than quantity of hair regrowth or that regrowth is less than loss. In any case, when it is detected, is when the hair loss is more than evident

Within this group of alopecia we classify **POSTTRAUMATIC, POST-NATAL and MENOPAUSAL, POST-FEVER and SCARING.**

POSTTRAUMATIC can be caused by surgery, head trauma, hats, veils or objects which permanently rub. By chemical products which irritate or modify the scalp and by hairstyles such as buns, pony tails, plaits, etc., which mainly happen in the fore-parietal area.

Treatment

Prepare the scalp by applying the Dermocapilar mask (ref. 28, 58) previously mixed with Herby (Ref. 25) and apply as though it was a dye, leave to act for 20 minutes, carry out this operation once a week on dirty hair.

Wash at least three times a week with Placent shampoo (Ref. 8) alternating with Royal Jelly shampoo (Ref. 35)

Apply after washing with Tricopeptides+Placenta Shock (Ref. 6) daily for 90 days.
