

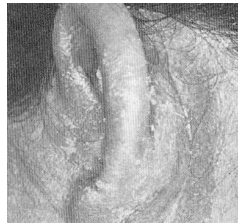
Dermatitis Seborrhoea

The first thing we need to know about this problem, is that it has no solution. We will never say that we are able to cure dermatitis, however we do try to temper, clean, calm, but never cure.

Dermatitis falls into the group of pathologies (problems) considered to be of unknown origin and because we do not know its origin, it has no solution.

It is characterised by red plates with badly marked edges with adhered greasy flakes and irritation and excess sweat.

The normally affected areas are, the capillary implantation line, eyebrows, nasal creases, behind the ear area (photo), and in the most severe cases, the moustache and chin area.



As causes, although it is not correct to say that fat decomposition exists, it normally appears in people with emotional changes, hormonal, dietary and congenital factors exist. In dry seasons such as summer it also has the tendency to appear.

TREATMENT

Prepare the scalp by applying Dermocapilar mask (ref. 28, 58) previously mixed with Herby (Ref. 25) and apply as if it were a dye, leave to act for 20 minutes, carry out this operation once a week to dirty hair.

Wash the hair at least three times a week with anti-oil shampoo (Ref. 17) alternating with Placent (Ref. 8).

Apply with Marine Anti-Dandruff (Ref. 204) alternating with Natural Anti-oil 12 Herbs (Ref. 46) at least 3 times a week for 90 consecutive days.

Dry and apply Reb cream (Ref. 205) to the affected areas daily.
